

## Extended EGP Congress, 2-4 February 2024

Proposal tabled by the EGP Committee

Taking into consideration the timeline of the European elections 2024 and wanting to give weight and significance to electing the EGP Lead Candidates and adopting our Common Manifesto,

the EGP Committee proposes:

- that the « regular » 38th EGP Congress 1-3 December 2023 will take place in a reduced and ONLINE format – dealing exclusively with statutory business and topical resolutions.

and

- to hold an **Extended Extraordinary EGP Congress between 2-4 February 2024**, kicking off our common European campaign and showing we are together and ready to lead, sending a strong message on our united vision for Europe.

Therefore, the EGP Committee asks its member parties to commit to:

- Prepare the planning for the nomination of the Congress Delegates in a timely manner, including the corresponding financial provisions, in accordance with the indicative list of allocated delegates which we will present at the Vienna Extraordinary Congress
  - Note that EGP will cover the costs of 4 nominated delegates – 6 nominated delegates in the case of Germany, France and UK – GPEW.
  - Note that the participation costs for delegates above the 4 delegates (or 6 delegates in the case of Germany, France and UK-GPEW) for travel costs, accommodation and participants fees will need to be covered by member parties
- Not plan overlapping events on the weekend of 2-4 February 2024

Considering the extraordinary nature of this Extended Congress and the need to focus on the adoption of the Common Manifesto and the election of the Leading Candidates, there will be no topical resolutions at the Extended Extraordinary Congress in February.

The five-year cycle of Extended EGP Congresses would start from the beginning of 2024.
