

## **Proposal regarding the mandate of the current Amendments Committee (AMC)**

Tabled by the EGP Committee

The EGP Committee proposes to prolong the mandate of the current AMC by 6 months until the EGP Congress at the end of 2024.

### **Background/history:**

- the current AMC was elected at the spring 2021 Council for a period of three years. It has known some changes since the election of the new Committee in spring 2022 at the Riga Council. Alexandra Medwedeff from the Austrian Greens was co-opted to replace Benedetta De Marte for supporting the 6th Congress in Copenhagen.
- Committee initiated the election of a replacement member at the 36th EGP Council in Copenhagen in December 2022 but postponed the election due to a gender balance issue.
- In March, the EGP Committee co-opted Kati Systä from Vihreät – De Gröna, Finland as AMC member for supporting the 37<sup>th</sup> Extraordinary EGP Congress in Vienna.
- In March also, Janik Feuerhahn announced he will stop as AMC member after the June 2023 Congress.
- Hence, Committee organises the election of two replacement members – at least one has to be a female member - at the 37th Extraordinary Congress.

April 2023, the Amendments Committee (AMC) supporting the decision making at the Congress in Vienna in June 2023 consists of:

#### **From Committee:**

- o Benedetta De Marte, Sec Gen EGP
- o Sibylle Steffan, Committee member
- o Mina Jack Tolu, Committee member (from January 2023; Mélanie Vogel until end 2022)

#### **From the member parties:**

- o Janik Feuerhahn, Bündnis 90/Die Grünen, Germany
- o Sam Murray, FYEG
- o Co-opted : Kati Systä, Vihreät – De Gröna, Finland

### **The Committee proposes:**

- to NOT organise the election of the new AMC in spring 2024 events that will be organised towards the European elections of (most probably) June 2024;
- to organise that election at the end of 2024, therefore to prolong the mandate of the current AMC until the end of 2024.

### **Vote:**

The 37<sup>th</sup> Extraordinary Congress prolongs the mandate of the current AMC until the end of 2024 when a new AMC election will take place.
