X (renumber after articles on resolutions and amendments committee) To allow a proper deliberation within the Member Parties and to improve the decision-making process at the Council, all documents up for vote have to be sent out to the Member Parties at a minimum of four weeks prior to the Council. Member Parties that would like to put a document up for vote should send it to the European Green Party Office at least five weeks prior to the Council. Unless otherwise specified in the Rule Book, these will be the default deadlines. Documents sent out to the Member Parties later than four weeks will need to be accepted to be voted upon by the Council at the beginning of the Council meeting. Member Parties and the European Green Party Committee can debate on the acceptance of these documents.
