2	EELV, France	25.5	add + modification, dividing the bullet point	The AMC: Can advise the Committee, when they see possible issues of validity of tabled draft documents.	25.5.1 The AMC has ten days to reach agreement on the validity of the draft resolutions	The same as there are deadlines for all our documents, we should have one for the amendments, and 10 days seems fair enough although this can be discussed
3	EELV, France	25.5	add	The AMC: Can advise the Committee, when they see possible issues of validity of tabled draft documents.	25.5.2 The Committee will follow the conclusions of the AMC on the validity of the draft resolutions, unless it has major reasons to oppose these. They should be communicated to the AMC for reconsideration in such a timeframe that the foreseen deadlines can be kept. If the AMC maintains its position the Council decides.
