

## Green Primary Schedule

Date	Action	What we ask from candidates and EU EGP affiliated Parties
September 04 – October 20	Call for Candidates	Candidates are asked to submit a candidacy form including personal details and material (quote, personal statement, social media details) for their online presentation. They will also have to send a two-page political agenda. EU EGP affiliated Parties are asked to confirm the <b>nomination</b> of their candidate by submitting the dedicated Party nomination form. Deadline: <b>before Sunday, October 20, 00:00am</b> CET (or October 19, 23:00 GMT)
October 21 – November 4	Supporting phase: Each EU EGP affiliated Party can express support for one candidate. Only candidates with the support of at least 4 and maximum of 8 affiliated Parties become contenders of the Primary.	During this phase EU EGP affiliated Parties can express their <b>support</b> for a candidate.
November 8-10	Launch of Primary (voting phase) at Autumn Council	By the launch of the Green Primary the EU EGP affiliated Parties will be asked to integrate the link/banner to the Green Primary voting platform on their websites.
November 10 – January 28	Primary Debates	During this phase we will involve affiliated Parties to organise online and offline debates
January 28	End of voting phase	
January 29	Media Event: Announcement of the results of the Primary	Presentation of the leading candidates in a press conference. Publication of the results on the websites of all EU EGP affiliated Parties.
February 21 – 23	Presentation of leading candidates at Electoral Congress	

### **We plan the activities around the Primary in the following weeks:**

- **November:** 2<sup>nd</sup> week (11-17), 4<sup>th</sup> week (25-30)
- **December:** 1<sup>st</sup> week (2-8)
- **January:** weekend of 1<sup>st</sup> week (10-12) and 2<sup>nd</sup> week (17-19), 3<sup>rd</sup> week (20-26)
